Installation

Here is some advice for setting up your Master Ant Farm!

Have you also ordered a colony and/or arena? Then we have supplied the connection material free of charge. Our advice is to always link your ant colony to the arena as shown in this instruction manual in two examples. The ants can then get used to take away their trash to and get food from the arena. You can set up the arena at your own discretion. Do not use too many natural materials to prevent molding. Also feed the ants in the arena. If they don't use the arena at all, this is the case

with small colonies regularly, occasionally offer some food in the nest/testtube. Your ant colony then probably moves to the gypsum at a later stage (if the colony is large enough).

Patience

Growing a colony requires (much) patience. So keep in mind that it may take some time for the ants to move. Some will do in a view days, but most of the colonies will wait till the amount of workers has grown exponential. Think about it as a breeding project of months or years and not days or weeks. Do the ants not move within a few days, then keep the nest tube well protected (dark), for example with a cloth, a piece of cardboard such as our protective sleeve, or the wooden test tube holders. If the colony has moved very quickly, do not leave the nest/testtube for a few weeks (minimal) as a backup for the colony and protect the nest, for example with our red protective foil.

Humidity

The gypsum is very easy to keep moist. Supplied is a 5 ml syringe for the Major and

General models or a 10 ml syringe for the 'Emperor'. Hold the syringe straight above the opening in the moisture reservoir (carefully against the plate) in the middle of your Master Ant Farm. Then spray the water into the reservoir. You'll see that the moisture is pulled into the gypsum because the gypsum turns darker. Make sure that a few rooms and corridors from the center become slightly damp and check this every few days. Keeping your Ant Farm humid only is required when your ant colony is housed in the gypsum. As long as the ants still use the nest tube try every few weeks or months to make the gypsum moisture to see if the colony wants to move in it. If they do not, then leave the gypsum dry again for the next period.

Long-term

Continue to provide your ants with sufficient nesting space and be careful with moisture. By the use in the long run (months/years) there may occur some unwanted space between the gypsum and the acrylic plates, the ants then can get a grip and bite through the gypsum. So keep checking your master regularly, tighten screws where necessary. The product can thus be used for 1 to 3 years. Replace and expand on time.
