### **--- Manual Triops eggs breeding ---**

Triops eggs

#### TIPS

- Use about a quarter of the eggs for each culture.
- Use a white tray or a white sheet under the tray to see the Triops properly.
- Use ordinary spring water (Bar le Duc or equivalent)
- Keep the water at a constant temperature between 23 and 29C °.
- A combination of artificial light and natural light works best.  
(minimum 40W incandescent lamp)
- A container of 0.3 to 0.4 liters is sufficient in the first 7 days.
- If the Triops do not hatch, use a different type of water (spring water).
- Do not add plastic toys etc. to the water, this can be toxic.
- Do not feed too much food, this will contaminate the water.
- Independent from 3 years under supervision and from 8 years of age.
- Sometimes the eggs do not hatch at the first contact with the water. You can then strain the eggs from the water and lay these 2 weeks to dry. Then you can try again, use another one kind of water as the first time.

The Triops will not hatch when;

- The water does not have the right temperature.
- Not the right water has been used (use only natural spring water).
- There is not enough light.
- The water is polluted.
